**Weekly Summary:**

Each student will submit a summary (750 words or more) of the previous week's presentation capturing the essence of the lecture. The summary should be submitted electronically as an email (not attachment) to [AAmin@Illinois.edu](mailto:AAmin@Illinois.edu). Summaries are due by 3:00 PM of the following class day. For easier identification place the course name and summary date in the Subject of your email (e.g. Arch-595IN, August 23 Summary). Be sure to copy yourself on the message for your record. Select High Priority for your message. Summary scores will be posted at the course web site periodically. Two lowest summary score for each student will be dropped at the end of the semester. Do not include bullets in your summary.

**Quizzes:**

There will be a number of quizzes during the semester. The lowest grade for each student will be dropped at the end of the semester. Make up quizzes will not be given.

**Final Exam:**

A comprehensive final exam is scheduled for 1:30–4:30 PM, Tuesday, December 13. Any changes to the time and place of the final exam will be announced in class later. Please do not plan to leave town before the confirmed scheduled final exam.

**Attendance:**

Due to the nature of the course, students are expected to attend class regularly. If you missed class for some reason, be sure to check with the course instructor or other students immediately for any announcements and/or assignments made in class. You are still responsible for them. Excessive absenteeism will have further affects on your course grade. **Missed Classes / Work:**
